12 **FACTS**

- 13 1. On January 8, 2005, St. Louis played Seattle at Qwest Field in
14 Seattle, WA.
- 15 2. St. Louis qualified by being the team with the highest record of the
16 NFC to not have won their division. Seattle qualified by being the
17 team with the worst record to have won their division.
- 18 3. St. Louis defeated Seattle 27-20.
- 19 4. The referees called nine penalties on the Seahawks, several of which
20 kept Ram drives alive when they would have faced fourth down
21 situations.

22 **RELIEF**
